

Sample TIA Expansion Plan for Daffodil ISD

DAFFODIL ISD'S MEDIUM DISTRICT CONTEXT

Daffodil ISD is a medium sized district serving grades PK-12 with 400 total teachers. For their first year, the district will include only teachers whose student growth can be measured by the STAAR Transition Tables. They intentionally want to start very small and build over time. They want to add in other grade levels/content areas that use either STAAR without Transition Tables, or a different third-party assessment in the second year. Then, year three will not changing any parts of the system to study implementation success. In and beyond the fourth year, the district will plan to expand so that by the end of year five, all teaching assignments will be included in their local designation system.
