What grades are covered?	Kindergarten-5 th Early Literacy and Reading Kindergarten-5 th Early Numeracy and Math
Is there a pre/post-test?	For the purpose of TIA, districts can use BOY and EOY benchmarks and goal setting through aimswebPlus.
What is aimswebPlus?	aimswebPlus is a K–5 assessment system used by schools and districts to support instruction through benchmark screening and ongoing progress monitoring. It provides educators with data in reading and mathematics to help identify student learning needs, monitor growth, and inform instructional and intervention decisions throughout the school year.
What was aimswebPlus designed to do?	aimswebPlus is designed to help educators screen students, monitor progress, and evaluate growth over time in reading and mathematics. The system provides data that supports instructional planning and helps schools identify students who may need additional academic support or intervention.
How can I use aimswebPlus?	aimswebPlus can be used to conduct benchmark screenings and monitor student progress in reading and mathematics throughout the school year. Educators use the data to identify instructional needs, group students, evaluate growth over time, and inform instructional and intervention decisions.
Does aimswebPlus provide expected growth targets for students?	Yes, aimswebPlus includes expected growth targets through its growth norms and Student Growth Percentiles (SGPs). The system reports seasonal and annual growth rates for reading and math measures and converts a student’s Rate of Improvement (ROI) into an SGP, which shows how a student’s growth compares to a national norm sample. These growth norms are explicitly used for goal setting and to describe the rate of growth a student must attain to reach an end-of-year performance target, allowing educators to establish expected growth benchmarks and monitor whether students are making adequate progress.

<p>How can districts use aimswebPlus to determine end-of-year student growth for purposes of TIA?</p>	<p>Districts can use aimswebPlus BOY and EOY assessment results and growth reporting to determine whether students met expected growth targets over the school year. Because TIA student growth is based on the percentage of students who meet/exceed an expected growth target, districts can use aimswebPlus reports (benchmark trends, progress toward goals, and exportable growth indicators) to document EOY growth and support local TIA calculations.</p>
<p>What types of data reporting capabilities are included with aimswebPlus?</p>	<p>aimswebPlus includes a range of student, group, and system level reports that allow educators and district leaders to review performance, monitor growth, and support instructional and accountability decisions. Reporting capabilities include individual student reports, classroom and grade level summaries, and district level aggregate views, with options to export data for end of year planning and state reporting.</p> <p>Examples of reporting available in aimswebPlus include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual student reports showing benchmark performance, growth trends, and progress toward goals • Group reports at the class, grade, school, or district level that summarize performance levels and growth patterns • Growth focused reports that display change across benchmark periods (e.g., fall to spring) • Exportable reports and data files that can be used for district analysis and state reporting needs • Role based access that allows teachers, campus leaders, and district administrators to view and export data appropriate to their role-based access
