What grades are covered?	3 rd –8 th grade Reading and Math, and Algebra I
Is there a pre/post-test?	Yes, for the purpose of TIA, PRoPL is an interim assessment system administered three times per year (fall, winter, and spring) to measure student progress toward end of year standards.
What is PRoPL?	PRoPL (Pearson Review of Progress and Learning) is a standards aligned interim assessment system designed to measure student progress toward end of year academic expectations in reading and mathematics. PRoPL assessments are administered during three designated testing windows—fall, winter, and spring—and are built using summative quality, on grade content aligned to state standards and assessment blueprints.
What was PRoPL designed to do?	PRoPL was designed to measure student growth and progress toward end of year academic expectations during the instructional year using standards aligned, summative quality interim assessments. It provides actionable data across multiple administrations to help educators identify strengths and areas of need, support instructional decision making, and reduce end of year assessment surprises.
How can I use PRoPL?	PRoPL can be used to monitor student progress toward end of year academic goals across the school year through fall, winter, and spring interim administrations. Districts and educators use PRoPL results to identify strengths and instructional needs, inform instructional planning, and support data driven decisions at the student, classroom, campus, and district levels
Does PRoPL provide expected growth targets for students? Yes/No Answer	No. PRoPL does not set or report expected growth targets for individual students. Instead, it measures student progress across multiple interim administrations and provides growth information through comparisons of performance over time rather than predefined growth targets.
How can districts use PRoPL to determine end-of-year student growth for purposes of TIA?	Districts can use PRoPL by examining student progress across multiple interim administrations and comparing performance over time, including alignment to end of year summative expectations. PRoPL provides standards aligned scale scores, performance levels, and growth visualizations that support districts in analyzing instructional impact and informing local growth determinations when used alongside summative assessment results and other district data sources.

What types of data reporting capabilities are included with PRoPL?

PRoPL includes comprehensive reporting at the student, classroom, campus, and district levels. Reports provide scale scores, performance levels, reporting category profiles, and standards cluster details, allowing educators to analyze overall performance as well as strengths and areas of need.

PRoPL reporting capabilities also include growth visualizations and cross interim comparisons, enabling districts to examine student progress across fall, winter, and spring administrations. Data can be viewed through interactive dashboards and exported to support local analysis and decision making.
